- Innovative Finance - We are about to launch the Peace Renewable Energy Credit (PREC).
- Policy and Advocacy - Our Powering Peace initiative with The Stimson Center aims to accelerate renewable energy deployments in crisis-affected communities.

- Our work supports communities in fragile countries facing the overlapping threats of conflict, climate change and energy poverty.
- We serve 27 countries that are home to 850 million people.
